# COMPUTER APPLICATIONS PROGRAM MICROSOFT EXCEL

START DATE: November 5, 2024

**END DATE:** December 12, 2024

### PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

This 45-hour/3 credit course introduces students to one of the most popular spreadsheet tools, Microsoft Excel. Students will enter and edit data, use formulas and functions, and format worksheets, charts and graphics. The skills gained in this course will enable students to effectively use Microsoft Excel to organize, analyze, and present data. Students need to have a working familiarity with Microsoft Windows and access to Microsoft Excel 2016 (or newer) to complete this course.

Note: Students will require access to a computer and the Internet during class sessions.

### **PROGRAM OF STUDY:**

- Perform operations necessary to create a worksheet within a workbook
- Understanding and editing operations
- Use formatting features to improve the appearance of the worksheet
- Create charts using various techniques
- Use Excel tools and functions to analyze data & MORF
