

COMPUTER APPLICATIONS PROGRAM FUNDAMENTALS OF OPERATING SYSTEMS

START DATE: January 7, 2025

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

This 56-hour/4-credit course will teach students how to install, configure, and maintain Windows and Linux-based operating systems.

Note: Students will require access to a computer and the Internet during class sessions.

PROGRAM OF STUDY:

- POST, BIOS, CMOS, UEFI, and the Boot Process
- Primary memory and how memory is managed by the operating system, including the use of memory caching
- The Windows Operating System and its basic functions
- Perform basics tasks using the Windows-based command shell languages and in the GUI
- The Windows GUI and software installs
- Install and configure an operating system and graphical user interface - and MORE!
